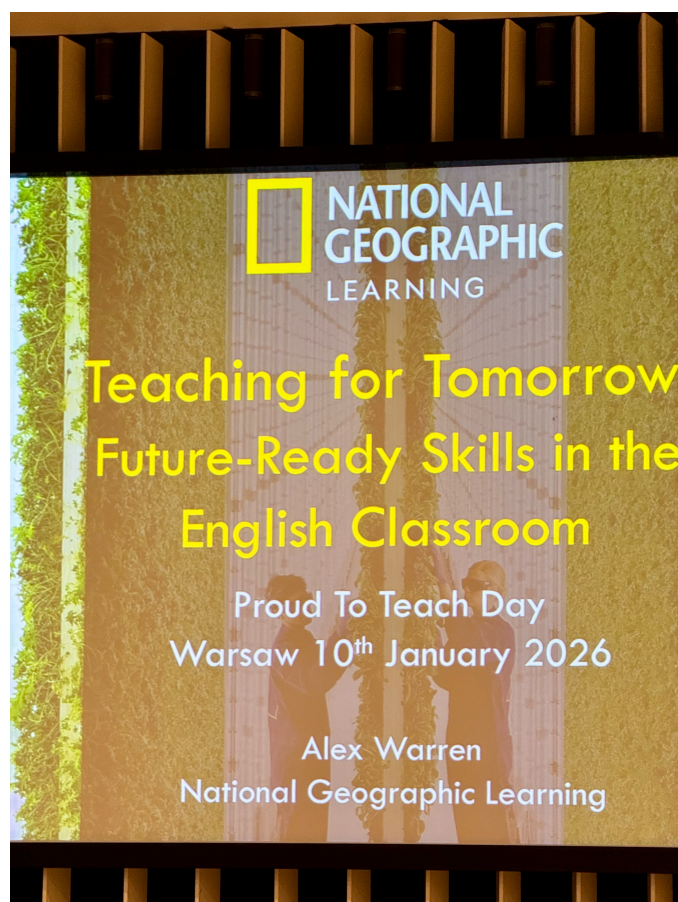


# TEACHING FOR TOMORROW FUTURE-READY SKILLS IN THE FOREIGN LANGUAGE CLASSROOM
